
ASIAN CRIMINOLOGICAL SOCIETY 4TH ANNUAL CONFERENCE

The Asian Criminological Society (ACS) is a Macao-based non-profit academic organization. It was established to encourage the research and cooperation amongst scholars and practitioners in criminology and criminal justice in Asia. By holding the ACS annual meeting, they can exchange academic and practical views and build a network within the international criminological community. The inaugural conference in 2009 was held in Macau, the 2nd and the 3rd were held in 2010 and 2011, in India and Taiwan respectively.



The Korean Institute of Criminology (KIC) is a national research institution in crime and criminal justice and provides specialized knowledge and information on crime prevention and policymaking. Its main research covers criminology, criminal law, criminal justice, corrections, crime statistics, recent crime trends and prevention methods and victimization. It actively works with counterpart organizations at home and abroad and carries out joint research, international (academic) conferences and colloquia. After being established in 1989, KIC successfully held the 12th World Congress on Criminology in 1998. Since 2004, KIC as a member of the international community, has joined the UNPNI (The United Nations Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice Programme Network). KIC also takes the lead in the Virtual Forum against Cybercrime (VFAC) and the Towards AsiaJust Program with UNODC.
